

Hon Hai Technology Group Biodiversity and No Deforestation Commitment

Hon Hai Technology Group is committed to preserving biodiversity and protecting the forests. We therefore issue Biodiversity and No Deforestation Commitment to publicly commit to our goals for sustainable operations. As global citizens, we have the responsibility to actively respond to climate change and preserve biodiversity. At Hon Hai Technology Group, we implement the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in our own operations, including SDG 14: Life below water, SDG 15: Life on land, and SDG 17: Partnerships for the goals. We moreover coordinate collaborative joint efforts with value chain partners for biodiversity conservation and no deforestation.

Principles and Commitments:

1. We uphold our core values for sustainable operations and human–wildlife coexistence. We strive to maintain global biodiversity by developing clean manufacturing.
2. We comply with relevant governments' regulations and guidelines. We avoid building facilities and having operational activities in globally or nationally important sites for biodiversity.
3. We aim for Zero Net Deforestation and comply with rules and regulations on forest management in places where we operate., avoiding excessive deforestation.
4. If it is necessary to conduct operations and/or other operational activities at/or near sites containing globally or nationally important biodiversity, we take measures to avoid, minimize, restore, and/or offset, reducing our ecological footprint. Suppliers across our supply chain are required to hold up to the same standards.
5. We adhere to the principles of “green, ecological, natural, zero emissions, recyclability, and net positive impact”, for preserving biodiversity and avoiding or minimizing pollution.

6. We leverage the Group's resources and influence to increase awareness on biodiversity and no deforestation among employees, shareholders, partners, suppliers, and external stakeholders to foster joint action.
7. We actively participate in actions to preserve biodiversity and respond to initiatives including the UN's Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD).

Principles and Commitments:

"Green, ecological, natural, zero emissions, and recyclability" has long been at the core of the Group's policy for environment management. We identify and minimize the impact that products and facilities have on the surrounding ecological environment, thus reducing adverse effects on the environment, the communities, and natural resources.
